ANNUAL DAY REPORT 2025-26 (13.02.2026)

Good evening Every one,

With great pride and gratitude, we present the Annual Report for the Academic Year 2025–2026. This year has been marked by academic excellence, outstanding achievements in sports, vibrant co-curricular activities, and continuous development in infrastructure and staff training. The school remains committed to providing quality education in alignment with CBSE guidelines, focusing on intellectual growth, character building, leadership skills, and social responsibility.

Academic Excellence:

1. We are very happy to share that our Grade X students achieved a 100% pass result this academic year. This accomplishment reflects the dedication of our students and the consistent guidance of our teachers.
2. We are especially proud of Master Aadithya, who secured a Centum in Computer Application, bringing great honor to our institution.
3. Our students also demonstrated excellence beyond academics. In the state-level “Soozhal – Environment & Sustainability Quiz,” conducted by the Tamil Nadu Climate Change Mission, among more than 13,000 participants, our students V.S. Vijayasri Hamshika of Class 8 and D. Samantha of class 6, were selected for the District Level.

CO-CURRICULAR AND SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS:

1. The inauguration of the Scouts and Guides unit was held on 13th October 2025. The programme was graced by Dr. S. Murali, H/WB, District Secretary, Avadi Educational District and District Training Commissioner. Their presence and guidance marked a significant milestone in strengthening leadership and service activities in our school.
2. Sports have been one of the strongest pillars of achievement during the academic year 2025–2026, and our students have actively participated in District, State, and South India level competitions, bringing pride and recognition to our institution. **Master D.N. Dhamani of Class I won the Gold Medal** in Boxing, demonstrating exceptional courage and skill at a very young age. She also participated in the South Boxing Championship – held at My Lady’s Park, Nehru Stadium. The Republic Day Boxing Match – 2026, and the CM Thiru Muthuvel Karunanidhi Stalin Birthday Boxing Championship – 2026.
3. **Master Jei Kishore of Class VI** actively participated in various chess competitions and secured prizes at different levels. He took part in the KR Trophy Thiruvallur District Level Children’s Chess Tournament held at S.B. Vijaya Reddiyar Matric Higher Secondary School, Avadi on 6th July 2025, and the Avadi Taluk District Level Chess Tournament conducted at Sri Aravindar Matriculation School, Veppampattu on 2nd November 2025.
4. **Master Thrishan of Class I participated** in the AMS Marathon held on 8th February and successfully completed the event, showing great enthusiasm and determination.

5. In the 7th District Level Silambam Championship held on 27th July 2025, **Master Saron and Master Enoch of Class III won Silver and Bronze Medals** respectively in the Single Stick category. In the Veer Kalai Silambam Inter-School District Level Competition at Avadi, several students won prizes in group and fighting events, and our school proudly secured the Overall Championship Title.
6. Students participated in the 5th District Karate Championship held at Subbarayalu Kalyana Mandapam, Red Hills, competing in Individual Kata events. **Master Deva Dharsan of Class IX** secured the Gold Medal. **Master Yokesh of Class VIII** and **Master Saron of Class III** won Silver Medals. **Master Hemkrish of Class IV, Nandika Prathsarathy of Class VIII, and Master Hariharan of Class IV** secured Bronze Medals, bringing pride and recognition to the institution.
7. The CM Trophy District Level Sports Meet was held on 23rd August 2025 at the District Collector Office, Thiruvallur. This six-day mega event witnessed participation from numerous schools across the district, and our students actively took part in various athletic and team events, displaying commendable performance, discipline, and true sportsmanship.

These achievements clearly reflect the dedication of our students, the committed guidance of our Physical Education Department, and the continuous encouragement and support of our parents and management.

Inter-School Competitions

1. Our students actively participated in various Inter-School Competitions during the academic year and showcased their talents in multiple fields. In the Talent Hunt organised by Nazareth College of Arts and Science, our students exhibited their talents in Dance, Song, and Guitar. The participants were honoured and appreciated by Ms. Srisha of Vijay TV Super Singer fame and Mr. Tippu, Dance Choreographer, which served as great encouragement for our budding performers.
2. Students from Classes VI to IX participated in the Inter-School Competition held at Mahaveer Rajasthani International School and won prizes along with cash awards in various categories. In the track events, our students secured the Third Prize in the 100 meters and 400 meters Relay, adding further pride to the institution.
3. Our students also participated in the OMC Inter-School Competition organized by the Rotary Club Olympiad at YMCA College, where nearly 30 schools took part in various events. Among them, our students participated in seven different events and displayed commendable performance and competitive spirit.

Events and Celebrations

1. World Environment Day was celebrated on 05.06.2025 on our school campus. Students organized an awareness rally carrying posters to spread the message of environmental protection and the importance of preserving nature.
2. International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21.06.2025. Mr. S.B. Srisathish, Arjuna Awardee, was honored on the occasion. He explained the benefits of yoga and demonstrated various asanas, encouraging students to practice yoga for their physical and mental well-being.

3. The Calyx Parent Orientation Programme was conducted on 12.07.2025 by Ratna Sagar to introduce parents to the Reading Eggs App and the Learning Management System (LMS), enabling them to understand the digital learning initiatives implemented by the school.
4. Educational Development Day (Kamarajar Day) was observed on 15.07.2025. The programme was graced by Mr. K.S. Ashok Kumar, Inspector of Police, T-11 Thiruninravur, along with his team.
5. A Drug Awareness Programme was conducted on 11.08.2025 by the Inspector of T-11 Police Station, Thiruninravur. Students took a pledge to stay away from drugs and were educated about the harmful effects of this.
6. The Investiture Ceremony was held on 24.09.2025 to develop leadership qualities among students by fostering responsibility, confidence, and school spirit through the delegation of authority.
7. Navratri was celebrated beginning on 24.09.2025 for nine days. Students from KG to Class IX participated in various performances with devotion and enthusiasm.
8. A Mobile Awareness Programme was organized on 29.10.2025 to educate students about responsible smartphone usage through skits and real-life examples.
9. A Girls' Child Awareness Programme was conducted on 06.11.2025 to promote empowerment, education, and well-being among girl students.
10. A Eye Camp was conducted on 10.11.2025 by Deepam Eye Hospital, Thiruvallur, for the benefit of students.
11. Children's Day was celebrated on 14.11.2025 as a bagless day filled with games and joyful activities. Students wore colorful dresses, and prize winners were honored with gifts.
12. Cancer Awareness Day was observed on 17.11.2025. As part of the newly initiated "Event Organization" programme by our school, in which one class

conducts an event every month, Grade IX students organized the programme featuring skits, dance, and mime performances to spread awareness and enhance leadership skills.

13. Edu Sphere was conducted on 22.11.2025 on our school campus. Students from Pre-KG to Class IX showcased their creativity and innovative projects, reflecting their hard work and academic learning.
14. The Eco Club Activity was conducted on 08.01.2026. Students planted saplings on the school campus and delivered speeches emphasizing the importance of saving water and protecting the environment.
15. The Scouts and Guides One-Day Camp was conducted on 28.01.2026. It was an intensive training programme designed to develop life skills, teamwork, and discipline. Students actively participated in practical activities and learned essential scouting skills.
16. Students who maintained 100% attendance for every quarter were honored to encourage regularity, punctuality, and discipline.
17. Parent-Teacher Meetings were conducted regularly after every Term Examination and Periodical Assessment to discuss students' academic progress and strengthen the rapport between parents and teachers.

Staff Development

1. A Training Programme on Financial Literacy and the Use of Digital Tools was conducted on 28.06.2025 at our school campus.
